



Renewable Energy

The Mustique Company has a renewable energy plan to be 75% reliant on solar and battery storage by 2024.

Solar PV Panels

The island runs on 15% renewable energy with the use of solar panels. We are currently using both diesel generators and solar PV.

Tesla Batteries

In 2017, The Mustique Company installed Tesla Batteries, which capture 1000 KWh. This is equivalent to leaving over 690 light bulbs on for 24 hours. The battery storage will help the island increase the use of renewable energy, and decrease its carbon footprint.

Carbon Report

In 2017, Mustique created a baseline study to determine the island's carbon emissions. Mustique has committed to reduce its emissions by 22% by 2025, in line with the St. Vincent & The Grenadines commitment to the Paris Climate Agreement. Considerate Hoteliers, an external organization, completed a carbon report which is available on our website.
